He also included information concerning potential future access to their property which has been cut off by V-DOT guardrails alongside U. S. 23 S.
- 2) Mr. Jones has prepared a draft amendment to the C-1 and C-2 zoning ordinance to include residential housing. These changes will be presented at a public hearing conducted by the Gate City Town Council.
- 3) Picnic tables for Gateway Park and the proposed dog park should be arriving within the next week.

NEW BUSINESS:

1) Mr. Tyler Smith came before the Commission to ask what, if any, permits he would need to conduct an on-line business from his home. The Commission, after examining the current occupations permitted in residential neighborhoods, agreed that on-line, in home businesses should be included in section 24-1-42 of the zoning ordinance.
