#### • Purchase pickup trucks

In the past, the Sanitation Authority has agreed to pay half for the use of vehicles, equipment, etc. The Town of Gate City has incurred the unexpected cost of hiring a CPA firm, and is also awaiting funding from VDH. With the need of vehicles imminent, the Sanitation Authority makes recommendation to purchase outright the F-250 Crew Cab regular bed vehicle at a cost of \$32,779.38. This would cost nearly the same as paying half for 2 vehicles. The Town of Gate City will purchase an F250 regular cab vehicle with a tool bed. (Revision)
